Texas A&M AgriLife Extension: Message from the Texas & D3 4-H Office

Our priority remains the safety of our employees, volunteers, attendees, and community. Decision-making regarding external programming is made at the local level, in conjunction with guidance from local health authorities and the Governor’s office. A [COVID-19 Screening Form](#) will be required to screen individuals prior to being granted access to events. Face coverings are no longer required on Texas A&M University campuses, pursuant to [Executive Order No. GA-36](#) issued by Texas Gov. Greg Abbott on May 18, 2021. The executive order also applies to all Texas A&M AgriLife facilities throughout the state, effective immediately at indoor and outdoor facilities and venues.

CLUB MEETINGS

4-H Clubs are the most traditional and effective delivery method of 4-H programming to youth. Club meetings are learning “laboratories” where members develop social skills including communicating and working with others, practice leadership skills, develop strong character, and become responsible citizens by participating in community service activities. It’s a wonderful way for youth to become exposed to new and exciting experiences and activities in a safe and familiar environment. Club Meetings are held once a month and generally include an ice breaker, inspiration, program, business, recreation and/or community service project. Meetings typically last 60-90 minutes. Pick a club meeting that best fits your schedule! Club Meetings & Times are published in the 4-H monthly Calendar.

On occasion a club meeting date may need to be changed due to a schedule conflict with facility, school event, holiday, volunteer illness, etc. Please check for 4-H email or facebook post for possible date changes as well as to make sure you’re on the club/project leader’s list should they have to call or send a last minute text. In case of bad weather, major sporting game, etc. (HS playoff) please contact the volunteer about possible cancellation and re-scheduling needs.
