

RECOGNITION OF JUNIOR 4-H MEMBERS

BRONZE AWARD

The Bronze Award is given to one or two deserving junior 4-H member(s) who has/have excelled in his or her project work.

Eligibility: Members who have completed two consecutive years as a 4-H member and have not passed their 11th birthday before September 1 of the current 4-H year.

Materials Required: 4-H Recordbook

Rules:

1. Must have completed two consecutive years as a Junior 4-H member.
2. Must not have passed their 11th birthday before September 1 of the current 4-H year.
3. Must complete a 4-H Recordbook.
4. Cannot receive the award more than once as a Junior 4-H member.
5. Must complete a 4-H Bronze Award Application.

Selection by: Out of county judges will review 4-H Recordbook and Application.

Judging Criteria:

1. Achievement
 - ✓ Completion of 4-H Recordbook
 - ✓ Local 4-H Club participation
 - ✓ County 4-H participation
2. Community Service
 - ✓ Individual, Local, Club and County
3. Leadership
 - ✓ Example: helping other members, recruiting members, club officers, committees, etc.

Suitable award will be secured and presented.
